Under each foot there is a lid that can be unscrewed in order to insert -into the transparent legs- sheets of paper with graphic designs, created by Marcel Wanders and Javier Mariscal, making the table easily and instantly customizable, and giving it as a whole a cheerful and amusing character.



Magis logo is stamped on each product of our collection vouching for their originality.









Legs: White 1673 C Top: White 8580
