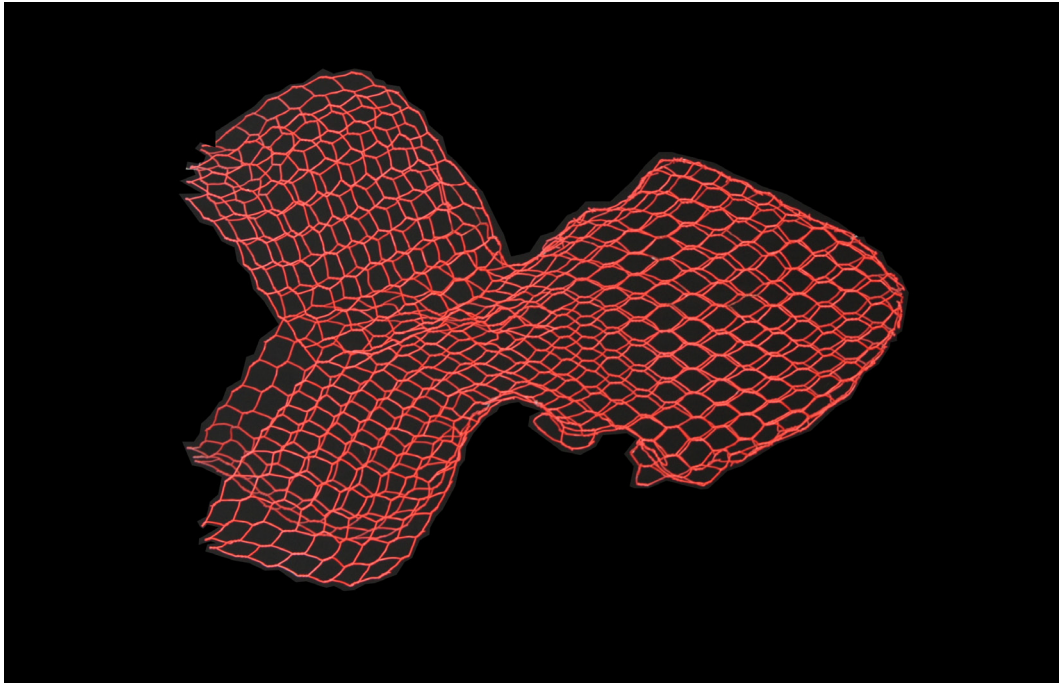


Fish — design Benedetta Mori Ubaldini, 2016

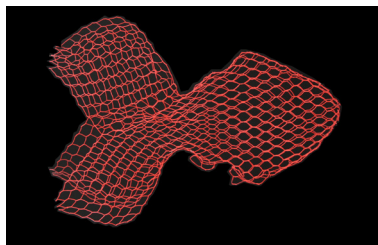
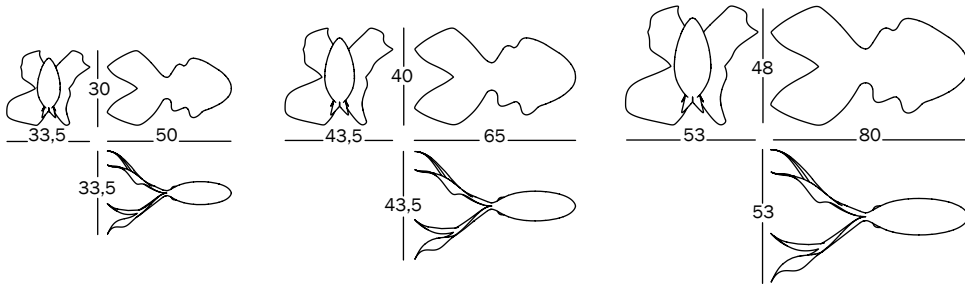
