

Before moving to Milan in 2005, Benedetta Mori Ubaldini lived and studied in London, where she studied Art and Design. Benedetta is best-known for her innovative and extraordinarily beautiful wire work. Each piece starts life as industrially produced, rolled "chicken" wire, which is gradually shaped by hand, twisting and joining the pieces together to give a seamless appearance.
