# Konstantin Grcic



## Profile:

Konstantin Grcic (born in 1965) was trained as a cabinet maker at the John Makepeace School for Craftsmen in Wood before studying Design at the Royal College of Art in London. Since setting up his own practice in 1991, he has developed furniture, products and lighting for leading design companies. Today, Konstantin Grcic Design is based in Berlin and is active in several fields ranging from industrial design projects, exhibition design and collaborations in architecture and fashion.


Among his industrial producers are Flos, Laufen, Magis, Muji, Nespresso, and Vitra. In the fashion and lifestyle sector his clients are a.o. Audi, Hugo Boss, Issey Miyake, Prada, Rado and smart/Daimler. Many of his products have been awarded international design prizes. He received the Compasso d'Oro in 2001 for the Mayday lamp (Flos), in 2011 for the Myto chair (Plank) and in 2016 for the OK lamp (Flos). For Tom and Jerry from Magis' series The Wild Bunch he received the German Design Award in Gold in 2011.

The world's most important design

museums (including MoMA, New York, Centre Pompidou, Paris, and Die Neue Sammlung, Munich) have included his designs in their permanent collections. The Royal Society for the Encouragement of Arts, Manufactures and Commerce (RSA) in England admitted Konstantin Grcic to the circle of Royal Designers for Industry in 2009 and in 2010 he was a fellow of the Villa Massimo in Rome. In 2016, Konstantin Grcic was honoured by the jury of the German Design Award with the Personality Award.

From 2020 to 2024 Grcic held a professorship at the Hamburg University of Fine Arts and has since been Honorary Professor. He has been appointed member of the Academy of Arts, Berlin in 2021 and of the Academy of the Fine Arts, Munich in 2022.

Grcic defines function in human terms, combining formal strictness with considerable mental acuity and humour. His work is characterised by careful research into the history of art, design and architecture and his passion for technology and materials.



# Design and

The starting point of this project was a specific manufacturing method: cast iron. It is one of the oldest ways of using ferrous metals. The manufacturing process has a physicality and rawness which is almost archaic. Iron foundries are heavy industries. Even though cast iron is widely known for its ornate and decorative applications, such as in Victorian-era garden furniture, the material has two distinctive characteristics: it is heavy, and it is strong. Cast iron performs well under compression, which is why it is used as a structural material for building bridges and, closer to the scale of furniture, bases for heavy machinery.

It is this use of cast iron which has inspired this collection designed by Konstantin Grcic. The project makes reference to cast iron's typical industrial uses and applies its material grammar to the realm of contemporary furniture.

The name stands for raw and untreated. A solid piece of iron, heavy and uncompromising. But also calls to mind the sweetness of sparkling wine, which speaks of refinement and sophistication, which is also inherent to our project.

With its original, fresh, feisty style, it encapsulates a sense of function and aesthetics that speaks volumes about the era we are living in, and it is instantly likeable, leaving people with a clear memory both of it and of the place where they saw it.

The Brut collection consists of a rectangular table, a height-adjustable trestle table, a round table, a small bistro table, two kinds of benches, as well as an armchair and a two or three-seater sofa.

Pair of trestles adjustable in height in cast iron painted in polyester powder. Can be ordered separately. Top in veneered oak (280x95 / 260x90 / 200x90) or in steel plate electrogalvanized (280x95) and painted in polyester powder. Can be ordered separately.







## PRODUCT CARE

Daily care and immediate stain removal will ensure that your wool upholstery will keep looking good for many years to come. It is normally sufficient to regularly vacuum and air upholstered product. Never use undiluted cleaning agents, bleaching agents, ammonia or soap intended for hard surfaces. As a general rule, many types of stain can be removed using warm water. For greasy stains, use a dry stain remover. For more insoluble stains (chewing gum, candle wax, etc.), use a plastic bag filled with ice to rub the stain until the substance has become friable. Use a clean flat blunt blade to delicately remove the substance. Be careful when using solvents, because these could dissolve the upholstery material beneath.

## WARNING

Do not use different cleaning products from the ones mentioned above. Do not use the product in an improper way. Do not place hot objects on it, sit down on the back, stand on the seat or use the product as a ladder. Once disused, please make sure this product is disposed in an environment-friendly way. For the fabric version: treat stains immediately, the longer they remain in the fabric, the harder it is to remove them. Before choosing a cleaning method, always try it out on a concealed part of the product. Magis is not liable for any damage to property or persons caused by an improper use of this product.

## PRODUCT CARE

We recommend using a soft rag, either dry or wet. When needed, use ph-balanced soap diluted in water. Do not use abrasive sponges as they may leave scratches. Avoid using acidic products, solvents and products containing ammonia. For tops in wood, we recommend using ph-balanced liquid soap especially formulated for wood, diluted in water. For tops in marble we recommend using water and Marseilles soap for cleaning. To remove greasy substances and various stains it is possible to use ammonia, denatured alcohol, bicarbonate and hydrogen peroxide. To remove scratches caused by a standard use of the top, rub the surface with a damp leather cloth. Any marks, signs or irregularities that may be visible on the stone tops are peculiarities of the materials and should not be considered as faults. Periodic and correct maintenance allows the product to keep its original aspect and lengthens the duration of its performance.
