Magis is **ISO 9001** and **ISO 14001** certified.

Magis obtained quality certification from the Swiss certification office SQS (IQNet partner) for its management system in 2004 and certification for its environmental management system in 2007.

ISO 14001 certification involves an environmental analysis to show that the organisation's management system adequately controls the environmental impacts of its activities, and seeks to improve its effectiveness and sustainability.

ISO 9001 defines minimum QMS requirements, and serves to assure consumers that an organisation's goods and services are maintained and improved.



AEO

Magis holds the AEO (Authorised Economic Operator) / Customs Simplifications and Security authorisation issued by the Customs and Monopolies Agency and is therefore an Authorised Economic Operator.

The status can be obtained by all economic operators, and their business partners, involved in the international supply chain who, in the course of their commercial activities, take part in activities regulated by customs regulations and qualify positively compared to other operators, as they are considered reliable and secure in the supply chain. In order to obtain AEO status, the economic operator must demonstrate compliance with strict criteria and standards.

Renewable-Energy Certificate of Origin

Magis has chosen to use 100% clean energy from renewable sources. The energy used at our Torre di Mosto headquarter is wind power and comes from the Buseto (TP) wind farm.

Code of Ethics

In 2022, Magis adopted a Code of Ethics that incorporates and formalises the values and lines of conduct in the performance of company activities.

Ecovadis

Magis was awarded with the Ecovadis Bronze Medal for the year 2023.

Ecovadis is one of the most important international corporate sustainability rating platforms. The impact assessment model, which is based on international standards such as GRI and ISO 26000, consists of verifying corporate performance through a questionnaire involving four areas: environment, employment and human rights, ethics, sustainable procurement. The answers are analysed by experts who attribute a score to the company. The scorecards issued provide information on environmental, social and ethical risks and are useful for implementing initiatives aimed at improvement.

An EPD® is a certified Environmental Product Declaration, which reports environmental data over the life cycle of products in accordance with the international standard ISO 14025. The International EPD® System is a programme to develop and register EPDs for any type of goods and services. The system is international, third party verified and deliver flexible source information.

Giocattoli sicuri (safe toys)

The Istituto Italiano di Sicurezza dei Giocattoli (IISG, a UL company) is responsible for certifying the safety of toys and children's products. It is a member of the most important national and international commissions that draw up safety regulations for children's products. Its mission is to check and certify the safety of everything in the child universe, from toys to clothing. The institute is officially recognised by the Ministry of Economic Development as a Notified Body to the European Commission.

CATAS

Catas is an accredited laboratory that performs various types of physical and chemical analysis in order to certify the safety, quality and reliability of products in the wood and furnishing sector. They verify that each material and product meets the requirements of national, European and international sector standards.

Magis products are tested to meet safety, quality and reliability requirements.

CARB

This certification verifies that our composite wood products are in compliance with strict formaldehyde emission standards as stipulated in the California Code of Regulations. All our MDF panels comply with CARB/TSCA Title VI certification and meet emission standards.

REACH

The REACH Certificate of Compliance is a document certifying that a product complies with EU REACH Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006.

Regulation 1907/2006 (REACH – Registration, Evaluation and Authorization of Chemicals) was introduced by the European Union to ensure proper and safe management of chemicals through rigorous registration, evaluation, authorisation and restriction procedures. The main references of the Regulation are Attachment XVII, which lists substances subject to restriction, and Attachment XIV, which lists substances subject to authorization.

The paints we have chosen to use are REACH certified and comply with the European regulation on the emission of toxic chemicals.

Electrical devices

Magis verified that the Linnut, Lost and Bouquet lamp collections met the safety requirements of the different countries. Below is a detailed description of the verifications that were carried out for each product.
